Scripture Lesson - 1 John 3:1-7 NIV Pg. 1900

¹ How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him.

² Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

³ Everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself, just as he is pure.

⁴ Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness.

⁵ But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And in him is no sin.

⁶ No one who lives in him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen him or known him.

⁷ Dear children, do not let anyone lead you astray. He who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous.

Scripture Lesson - 1 John 3:1-7 First Nations Version

¹ Behold the greatness of the love shown to us by our Father the Great Spirit that he would call us his children! And so we are! The ones who belong to *the ways* of this world do not know the Giver of Life, so they do not see us in this way.

² Much-loved friends, we are now Creator's children. It is not yet clear what we will be. But we know that when the Chosen One appears, we will be like him, for we will see him as he truly is.

³ All who through him have this hope will keep themselves pure, in the same way that he is pure.

⁴ All who walk in broken ways are trampling over the law *of the Chosen One*, for all broken way go against his law.

⁵ You know he came to do away with bad hearts and broken ways and that in him there are no broken ways.

⁶ The ones who remain in harmony with him do not walk in broken ways. Those who walk in broken ways have not truly seen or known him.

⁷ *My* much-loved children, do not let anyone take you down the wrong path. The Chosen One always did what was right. So the ones who keep walking his right ways show that they are in good standing with him.

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
